Cape Winelands Cycle & Wine Experience

Cycling through the beautiful vineyards of the Cape Winelands (Stellenbosch & Franschhoek). Wine tasting at some of the region's best wineries, exploring small scenic routes with views of the valley, and experiencing the best food and coffee in the area. Each night, you will be staying in the heart of Stellenbosch. We choose to avoid some of the more commercial wineries during our itineraries by sticking to the more boutique family-run vineyards that offer more intimate experiences and higher quality of wine in our opinion. The region is also brimming with boutique shopping, restaurants and history to fill up the day.

This area offers something to all levels of mountain bikers whether beginner, intermediate or advanced. There is challenging world class single tracks featuring both natural rocky trails and fast flow trails.

Alternatively beginners may choose to meander through the vineyards on the gravel roads between wine tasting stops and take in the breath taking views.

There will always be a private guide and vehicle on duty to transfer you to and from lunches and dinners. Please let us know if there is a particular restaurant/winery that you would like to visit that we can book in advance for you.

Day 1

Features the Tokai trails in Cape Town these are rocky natural trails with a lot of flow, easily the best riding in Cape Town. Start and finish point is Groot Constantia Vineyards. The oldest winery in South

Africa and a truly amazing estate. Lunch is on offer here after the ride. After lunch and possibly wine tasting we transfer to the accommodation in Stellenbosch. There is a lot of amazing restaurants in the area for dinner.

Day 2

Moves guests to the Cape Winelands featuring Stellenbosch and Franschhoek, Stellenbosch being the second oldest town in South Africa best known for it's world class wine estates and food culture.

It also features amazing trail networks such as Jonkershoek and Banhoek. This region is truly beautiful and it allows riders to immerse themselves into nature riding world class trails.

On this day we take guests to the Jonkershoek trail network for an unforgettable ride. After the ride we experience the town's history and wineries.

Day 3

Day 3 features the Banhoek valley which is super interesting as it features all different types of trails, from rocky and sandy to hardpack flow trails this contrast leaves a riders buzzing.

The ride ends at Boschendal which is one of the most notable wineries in the area, however they do a lot more than wine. Producing world class fruit and dairy products. They offer an amazing lunch in their beautiful courtyard, surrounded by Cape Dutch architecture.

This concludes our experience and we will make our way back to Cape Town after lunch.




The Cape Winelands is home to over 500 wineries. The Cape Winelands is a world-class destination for any wine lover.
